=> place of Truth tangible, tactile,

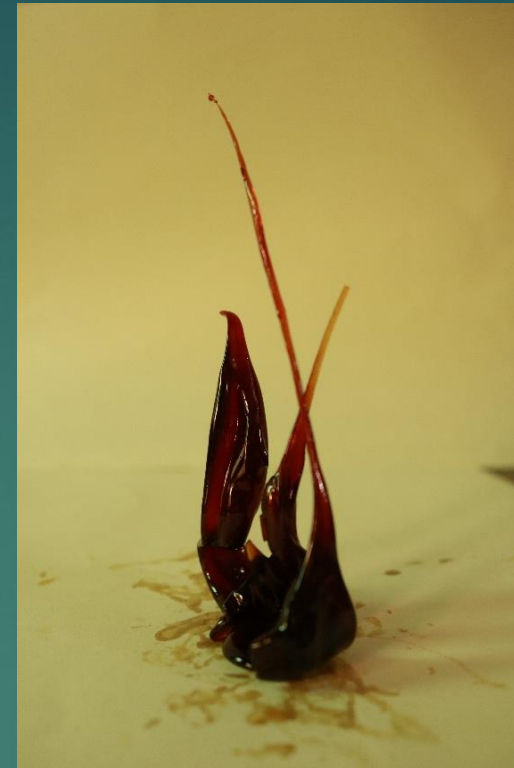
Long exposure short exposure.

## Idioms

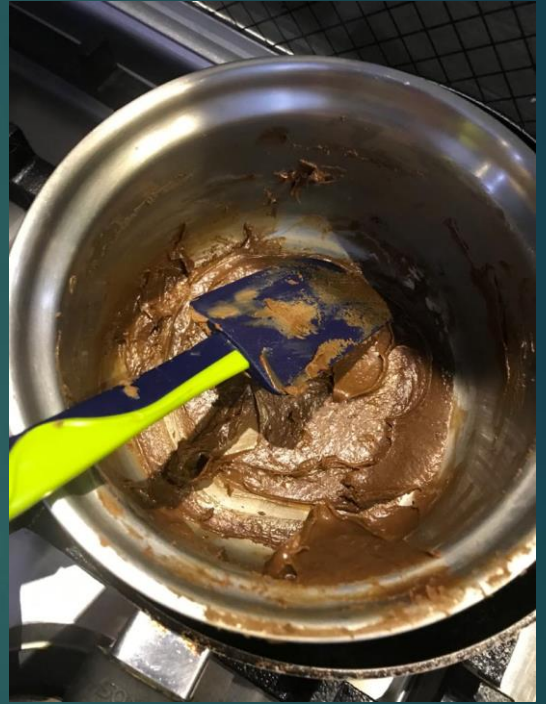
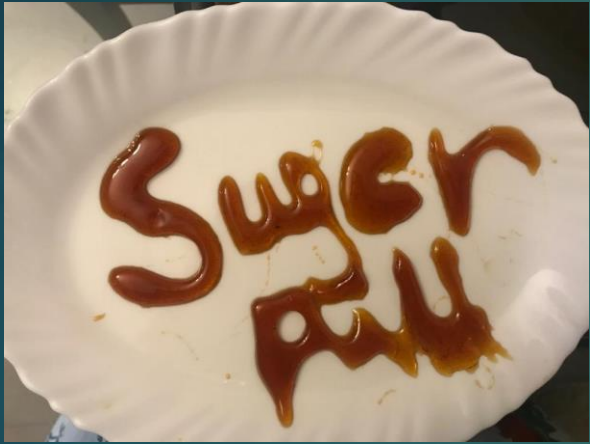
